

Order No. 81/2024

of the Rector of Jan Kochanowski University of Kielce

of 18 July 2024

on the appointment of a Team for Ensuring Accessibility for Persons with Special Needs at the Jan Kochanowski University of Kielce

Pursuant to Article 23(1) and (2)(2) of the Act of 20 July 2018 – Law on Higher Education and Science (Journal of Laws of 2023, item 742, as amended) and § 28(1)-(2), § 29(2) of the Statute of the Jan Kochanowski University of Kielce, the following is hereby ordered:

§ 1

1. A Team for Ensuring Accessibility for Persons with Special Needs at the Jan Kochanowski University of Kielce (hereinafter referred to as the Team) is hereby established.
2. The Team is appointed for the term of office of the Rector.

§ 2

The Team consists of:

§ 3

1. The Team's tasks include monitoring accessibility at the University, proposing and developing solutions for implementing accessibility, and initiating actions necessary to ensure accessibility for persons with special needs.
2. The tasks referred to in paragraph 1 will be carried out, inter alia, through:
 - 1) analysis of the needs, requests and other demands reported by persons with special needs, including disabilities;
 - 2) discussion on the effective adaptation of the education process without compromising

- academic standards;
- 3) developing guidelines for creating a support system for persons with special needs at the University;
 - 4) developing a catalogue of good practices in ensuring accessibility at the University;
 - 5) developing proposals for changes to the admission process;
 - 6) cooperating with organisational units within their competences in ensuring accessibility;
 - 7) submitting proposals for provisions in draft internal normative acts;
 - 8) developing a plan for implementing accessibility at the University.
3. Other persons invited by the Chair may participate in the work of the Team in an advisory capacity.
 4. The Team will meet as needed, but at least once per semester of the academic year.

§ 4

This Order shall enter into force on the date of its signing.
